

## Sunset over Connel Bridge

32 bar strathspey for 3 couples in a 3 couple set

- 1 - 4 1C cast off one place and set advancing to face 1<sup>st</sup> corner.  
2C step up on bars 1 and 2.
- 5 - 16 2C, 1C and 3C dance to each corner and set, 1C finish in 2<sup>nd</sup> place opposite side. (on bars 15 and 16, 1L dances up side line to 2M position while 1M dances down side line to 2L position.
- 17 - 18 1L and 2M; 1M and 3L change places giving RH.  
(Middle couple to the right)
- 19 - 20 3L and 2L; 2M and 3M change places giving LH.  
(Middle couple to the left)
- 21 - 22 3M and 1L; 2L and 1M change places giving RH.  
(Middle couple to the right)
- 23 - 24 All cross back to own side giving RH.
- 25 - 32 1C and 3C dance The Chain Progression.
